

To talk about the things that people like, use gustar + noun

If what is liked is singular, use the form gusta

*Me gusta el cereal. =The cereal is pleasing to me.

If what is liked is plural, use the form gustan.

*Te gustan las uvas. = The grapes are pleasing to you.

(A mí) me	nos
(A ti) te	os
le	les

*To stress that something is really liked, add the word

“A” + the subject(s) who like it.

A mí me gusta el pan. =The bread is pleasing **to me!**

A María le gustan los huevos.=The eggs are pleasing **to María!**

***Notice that the forms of gustar match what is liked, NOT the person who likes it!**
